White Sands Missile Range: Loral Data Systems is a "Quality–Oriented Contractor"

Claude P. Malone, WSMR Contracting Officer's Representative for the acquisition, had a barrage of praise for the two systems we shipped in 1989 and 1990.


WSMR's April 19th newsletter, Missile Ranger, quoted Mr. Malone as saying, "This versatile high speed telemetry system should support our testing requirements for the next 10 to 15 years.

"In my 33 years of experience with the government, a large portion of which has been involved with instrumentation acquisition, I have not experienced such a successful acquisition.

"I believe this was achieved through the cooperative efforts of our employees and the proposal evaluation effort which selected a quality oriented contractor (Loral Data Systems) ."

White Sands Missile Range (WSMR) is the largest overland test range in the United States. Operated under the direction of the Department of Army, the mission of WSMR is to provide an instrument test range for research, development, and testing of missile systems for the Department of Defense (DoD), NASA and other users.





WSMR electronic engineers work with their technician to load Loral's TDHS system and check its status.

The Telemetry Data Center (TDC) at WSMR provides real-time processing and display of various missile system telemetry data. This data provides the user with information on system performance, aids in the GO/ NOGO decision for firing, and provides the Missile Flight Safety Officer with critical data to ensure a safe flight within specified boundaries.

The TDHS provides cost effective telemetry data processing while ensuring the data quality and data integrity required by Range customers. The range supports approximately 700 missile tests a year. Loral's on-site Field Service Support person is **Tom Tonkin**.





Amy's dad, John, is a Hardware Technical Specialist in Telemetry Engineering, Sarasota.




JESSICA PEET
