

EXCITING NEWS FROM BUSCH GARDENS . . .

The largest and fastest steel roller coaster in the southeastern United States, "Kumba," will make its debut at Busch Gardens Tampa this spring.

Kumba, which means "roar" in the African Congo-language, will exceed speeds of 60 mph, carry passengers more than 140 feet up in the air, and provide a maximum g-force of 3.75 during the 2-minute, 54-second ride. Kumba will include three first-of-a-kind maneuvers: a "diving loop," a camelback with a 360-degree spiral, and the world's largest loop.
